3. Overview

LashRight helps you model and review container stacking arrangements during vessel design and operational load planning. Its advanced matrix solution models the complex behaviour of stacks and lashings, ensuring compliance with LR Rules and Regulations for the Classification of Ships, Part 3, Chapter 14.

LashRight quickly identifies components that exceed the Rule requirements, helping the user make the necessary changes to the container arrangement, weight distribution or lashing equipment.

6. Known limitations

- The software has been tested on Windows 10 personal computers.

- For the Rule Versions July2013, July2014, July2015 and July2016 the calculation does not include the impact of the longitudinal force of the lashing rod on the container corner posts.
- Wind loading is to be applied manually for Rule Version July2013, July2014, July2015 and July2016.

7. How to register a LashRight licence

7.1 Installing LashRight

LashRight can be downloaded from the Lloyd's Register website here: <https://www.lr.org/en/lashright/>.

You will need to have Windows Power User or higher administrative rights to install the software and register a licence. If you are uncertain about the user rights that you have on your computer, please confirm it with the IT Department in your organisation.

7.2 Entering User Information for a new licence

You will be prompted to activate LashRight the first time it starts. Go to LashRightSolver > Licence Manager and enter the user information in the LashRight Licensing Dialog. This information and the hardware signatures on your machine will be used to generate a licence request file automatically. You can email this file to the LashRight support team by clicking on the **Email Request** button. Alternatively, you can choose to save the request file by clicking on the **Save Request** button and send the file to es.support@lr.org later.

7.3 Activating a licence

The LashRight support team will generate a licence file after receiving a licence request. Upon receiving the licence file, you should restart LashRight and go to LashRightSolver > Licence Manager in the main menu to bring back the Licensing Dialog. The licence file can be imported by clicking on the Activate Licence button. If the registration is successful, you will see a message showing the number of remaining days for time-limited licences:

7.4 Checking the status of a licence
